- ◆ **Bud Biglieni** is in Mercy Hospital (St. Johns) Rm 7171 due to ambulatory difficulties.

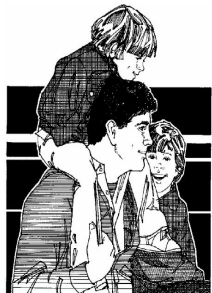

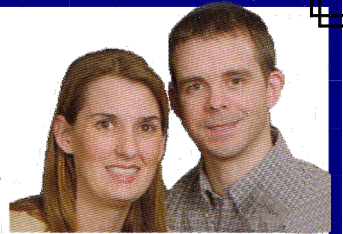

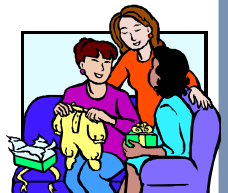
