HAITI RELIEF

Our church family contributed \$7,073 toward the relief effort in Haiti. \$1,000 of these funds went to Harding University for the Tents and Tarps project to house those who are homeless. The remainder of the funds was split evenly between the West Broward Church of Christ in Florida who supports missionary Joe Worndle there in Haiti and the Estes Church of Christ in Tennessee who supports the Son Light Children's Home and Santo Nutrition Center in Haiti.
