For the last few weeks, I've been reading a book written by Hal Runkel called, "Scream Free Parenting." You may have seen some of the highlights I shared on social media. Now I consider myself a pretty calm person and yeah, a calm parent. Patient? Definitely! Understanding? Absolutely! And as a calm parent, I absolutely love and adore the attention of my son. However, in recent weeks, I've noticed the number of times my son says, "Daddy? Daddy!? DADDY!?!?", has increased ten-fold! Mere coincidence I wonder? Have you ever found yourself in the bathroom and you hear little fingers tapping on the door? That's the sound of my last nerve breaking before I scream for a moment of peace. In hindsight, my responses lately haven't been all that great. Let me remind us of a few points from Hal's book.

- 1) Parenting is not about kids, it's about parents** – Emotional reactivity is our worst enemy when it comes to having great relationships.
- 2) If you're not under control, then you cannot be in charge** – To be "in charge" as a parent means inspiring your children to motivate themselves.
- 3) Growing up is hard to do, especially for grown-ups** – Seeking our own maturity makes for a vibrant, stimulating and mutually loving relationship with each of our children.
