FAMILY FOCUS

Good morning, and welcome to Sunset! Let these words of 1 Chronicles 29:11 (CSB) call you to worship today: "Yours, Lord, is the greatness and the power and the glory and the splendor and the majesty, for everything in the heavens and on earth belongs to you. Yours, Lord, is the kingdom, and you are exalted as head over all."

This morning during our sermon time we will see Israel go from the highest of highs to the lowest of lows incredibly quickly. The excitement of their Red Sea deliverance wears off soon after they travel through the wilderness for three days without water. Their experience models our lives well. Our baptism was a mountaintop moment-it was a Red Sea experience-but it wasn't long after we dried off from the baptistry that we were plagued with temptation and challenging circumstances. Little did Israel know that the wilderness was crucial for them to learn to be God's people. Getting Israel out of Egypt was one thing, but getting Egypt out of Israel was quite another. Even though Israel's status as slaves had changed, they still had a long way to go to trust in the Lord and serve him in the way God desired. God used the bitter circumstances of the wilderness to teach them these lessons, and he uses the bitter circumstances of our wilderness experiences to do the same.
