

FAMILY FOCUS

Good morning, and welcome to Sunset! Let these words of **Zephaniah 3:17** (CSB) call you to worship today: "The Lord your God is among you, a warrior who saves. He will rejoice over you with gladness. He will be quiet in his love. He will delight in you with singing."

Leadership is hard. This is true not only in a church context but also in several other areas. Leaders take heat for their decisions, they regularly put out fires, and at any given time, there is someone who is unhappy with them. In our text today, Moses is feeling the total weight of leadership. Jethro recognizes that Moses is headed for burnout that will affect him and all of God's people, and he says that Moses needs to appoint some other faithful men to help him lead Israel. This passage is rich with information about what good, godly leadership looks like and what the beautiful outcome is whenever our leaders are as healthy as possible. Whether you are an elder, deacon, minister, teacher, mom, dad, boss, or in some other place of leadership, I pray what we reflect on will benefit you!


