



Sunset Little Youth Programs

The Sunset Little Youth Group consists of children from ages 2 to 12. Our program is designed to nurture relationships and create stronger bonds between families and children by providing a Christian environment to play, learn, and grow spiritually.

Faith Building

Sunday morning Bible classes are available for all ages from 9:30-10:15. Children are engaged in age appropriate lessons while parents are able to choose from a variety of classes that cater to their spiritual needs. **Wednesday evening Bible classes** expand on what was learned on Sunday morning.

During the second service on Sunday mornings, **Children's Bible Hour** is available for all children ages 2 through kindergarten. This allows children to learn in an age appropriate environment and lets parents be able to focus on the sermon.

Leadership Training for Christ (LTC) is a state wide event that we participate in where the kids are involved in a variety of events such as puppet skits, regular acting skits, public speaking, singing, etc.

Service Projects

Food for Friends is a partnership with Care to Learn in which we collect food for school children in need.

In August the entire congregation collects items for a **Back Pack Drive**. The Little Youth places the items into the backpacks.

During our **Kids Crafty Christmas** event, we have lunch after church services and then create items that will bring holiday cheer to our soldiers overseas and the shut-ins living right around us.

We join in with the Sunset Youth Group and travel to the area nursing homes to do some **Christmas Caroling** (and hand out some of the things we made at the Kids Crafty Christmas event the previous month)

Family Building

In the winter, we go **bowling** as a group and then meet for lunch.

The **Spring Fling** is our annual egg hunt. After services, we have some lunch at the church and then hunt for the elusive candy filled eggs.

Each year, we reserve a block of seats at a **Springfield Cardinals** game.

Around June we do a single night **campout** at a private farm in Crane. There's a spring fed creek that that kids swim in, plenty of smores and hot dog roasting, and firefly chasing that takes place at this annual event.
